7 & 8 Years Old	50

## PITCHERS LEAGUE AGES 14 AND UNDER MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING REST REQUIREMENTS:

### IF A PLAYER PITCHES:

- ✓ 36 50 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed
- ✓ 21 35 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar day of rest must be observed
- ✓ 1-20 pitches in a day, zero (0) calendar day of rest is required before pitching again

#### NOTE:

- 1. A pitcher who delivers 41\*\* or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day.
- 2. A catcher who catches in 4 or more innings in a game may not pitch the remainder of the day (catching 1 pitch = 1 inning)
- 3. Per Concord American Bylaws:
  - a. Single A/Farm Division pitchers may only pitch a maximum of two (2) innings per calendar week (Sunday Saturday)
  - b. Players are not allowed to play more than three (3) innings in any infield position and no more than two (2) innings in the same infield position.

\*EXCEPTION: If a pitcher reaches the MAXIMUM of pitches for his/her league age while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until that batter reaches base, that batter is retired, or the third out is made to complete the half-inning.

\*\*EXCEPTION: If a pitcher reaches a day(s) of rest threshold while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until that batter reaches base, that batter is retired, or the third out is made to complete the half-inning. The pitcher will only be required to observe the calendar day(s) of rest for the threshold he/she reached during that at bat, provided that pitcher is removed before delivering a pitch to another batter.
